The students are responsible for taking their character's parts and advocating for their interests in an un-scripted debate about the geopolitics of Middle-earth in light of the finding of the Ring. There have been some great moments in these debates: in 2008 I asked the student representing Saruman "What do you have to offer to Middle-earth?" and in an utterly deadpan voice he said: "Hope and Change." There was a short pause followed by mass laughter. In 2018, in response to the same question, the student representing Saruman said: "With the Ring I would build a BETTER Dark Tower! The Best Dark Tower! The BEST! I understand Dark Tower building probably better than anyone else in Middle-earth! And it would be the biggest, most beautiful Dark Tower EVER!"
